Make Your Own Piggy Bank

A piggy bank is a great place to put your money until you can get to the credit union and make your deposit. Here's a fun (messy) way to make your own piggy bank with the help of a grown up. Make sure you wear old clothing and cover your work area with lots of newspaper. Use paints, markers, crayons or whatever to be as creative as you'd like.

WHAT YOU'LL NEED:

Homemade paste (see paste recipe)
 Newspaper
 Scissors
 A balloon
 Masking tape
 Cardboard
 One cup from an egg carton
 Pipe cleaner
 Paint
 Paint brushes
 Hodge Podge (like a varnish-can be found in craft stores)

PASTE RECIPE: Ask a grownup to help. Combine six cups of water with three cups of flour and heat until mixture is like a thick cream. Allow mixture to cool.

WHAT YOU DO:

1. Blow up the balloon and tie a knot at end. This will be the pig's body.
2. Cut or tear newspaper into strips.
3. Tape the cup from egg carton on the knot end of the balloon.
4. Cut two ears from the cardboard and tape onto the balloon.
5. To make the legs:
 - A. Cut two circles from the cardboard.
 - B. Cut circles in half.
 - C. Take each half circle and form cones.
 - D. Attach the leg with tape to the underside of your pig.
6. Cut and bend pipe cleaner into a curly tail and tape onto the large end of the balloon.
7. Paste on approximately 4 layers of newspaper strips over the entire pig.
8. Allow to dry for at least two days. (waiting is the hard part)
9. Ask a grown up to cut a rectangular slot at the top of your pig, and then burst your balloon with a pin.
10. Decorate with paints, crayons or markers. You can also glue pieces of fabric, buttons or ribbons to your pig.
11. Apply at least one coat of Hodge Podge to strengthen and protect your masterpiece. Have lots of fun and be proud! You have created your very own piggy bank. Now **SAVE-SAVE-SAVE!**

2009 LINCOLN BICENTENNIAL ONE CENT PROGRAM

In 2009, the United States Mint (the place where they make money) will make four different one-cent coins. This will be to recognize the bicentennial of President Abraham Lincoln's birth and the 100th anniversary of the very first Abraham Lincoln penny. The new penny design was first seen on September 22 at a special party held at the Lincoln Memorial on the National Mall in Washington, D.C. While the front side of the penny will continue to show the face of President Lincoln that is now on the one-cent coin, the back side will show four different designs. Each one will represent a different part of the life of President Lincoln. The pennies will soon be available at the credit union. Are you interested in learning more money facts?
